BJÖRN ULVAEUS

Ulvaeus and bandmate Benny Andersson branched off into musical theatre. With Tim Rice, they wrote *Chess*, a concept album and stage show in the mid-Eighties. They were later involved with the Abba musical, *Mamma Mia!*

AGNETHA FÄLTSKOG

Pursued a solo career in the Eighties. But a fear of flying has limited her travels, prompting reports that she is reclusive. Her new record *A* is out in May; it's actually her second comeback, following 2004's album *My Colouring Book*

BENNY ANDERSSON

After working on *Chess* with Ulvaeus in the late Eighties, Andersson released a couple of folk albums. With his big band, the modestly named BAO – Benny Andersson's Orkester – he continues to record music

ANNI-FRID LYNGSTAD

She recorded with Phil Collins in 1982; *Something's Going On* became a hit. A second solo album, *Shine*, did not. In 1992, she married a prince. In 1996, she released a Swedish-language record which was big in, well, Sweden
